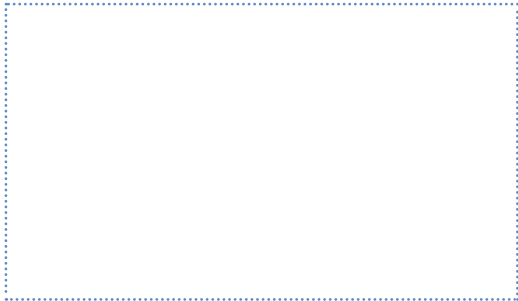

## Why?

## What is that?

## How does it work?



*Even extremely discolored teeth can be lightened with this method.*

*The treatment lasts approximately an hour.*

1. Make an appointment with your dentist for a consultation about teeth whitening.
2. The dentist determines whether your teeth can be whitened and explains the procedures involved.
3. An appointment is made to whiten the teeth.
4. Before the whitening begins, the teeth are cleaned and the gums covered with a liquid plastic for protection.
5. After the whitening gel has been applied to the teeth the laser is used.
6. Each tooth will be exposed to the laser for a few seconds in order to activate the gel.
7. Activated Oxygen penetrates the tooth enamel and destroys the staining pigment deposits.
8. After the gel residue and liquid gum protector has been removed, the teeth are treated with fluoride gel.
